QUALIFICATION OF ACADEMIC STAFF

The ESL department has 35 full time and qualified academic staff: 16 are with PhD degrees (of which 6 are full professors), 7 are completing their PhDs and the remaining 12 are with Master's degrees. All staff are qualified and competent to teach and manage learning activities according to the standard set up by the Ministry of Research and Higher Education. Their areas of expertise are within the fields of agricultural economics, resource economics and environmental economics.



NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

The ESL department has Summer Course, Wintercourse, ESL Joint Seminar - Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) activities with lecture halls with a capacity of 60 people and 100 people equipped with teaching facilities such as LCD, wireless and wifi IPB-ACCESS. In addition, the ESL Department also has a special room for seminars and trial examinations, a reading room with up to date books and literature, a network of cooperation with various institutions, universities, companies and various domestic and foreign organizations.
